Congress is in recess in August, so there isn't much happening on Capitol Hill. However, your Federal Legislators now have time to spend here in Nevada to meet with constituents in their Districts. Both the U.S. House and Senate are expected to return to Washington from the August District Work Period on September 8th for a few weeks of legislative business before adjourning for the November Elections.

House of Representatives Key Initiatives

Kevin McCarthy (R-CA), US House Majority Leader, sent a memo outlining three key initiatives (but not all) that the House will be focusing on in September:

- 1. A consolidated energy package
- 2. A jobs package
- 3. Legislation passed by the House Energy and Commerce Committee that would allow those who purchased health care on the group market to keep the plans they had

EXCHANGE INFORMATION

Nevada is now considered a "Supported State Based Exchange".

- o To sell plans on the Exchange, you must be certified by CMS.
- Please be sure that you enter your correct National Producer Number (NPN) as this is how
 CMS will advise the carriers that you are the selling agent
- o You must complete an online training (a very good training, by the way). If you haven't registered for and/or taken the training yet, you may see an overview of the registration process here: Registration Overview
- o Once you have completed your healthcare.gov/Exchange training, please confirm whether the carrier needs the Certificate of Completion for their files.
